Osteoporosis Workshop

- 1. Body composition and bone microarchitecture is used to evaluate sarcopenia and sarcopenic obesity
- 2. DXA can also be used to diagnose acquired and inherited lipodystrophy
- 3. Body composition analysis by DXA, even helpful in patients on glucocorticoids and explain the metabolic disparity
- 4. Lateral DXA scan in elderly patients for aortic calcification
- 5. HSA (Hip Structural Analysis) is useful in monitoring treatment and recovery from osteomalacia
- 6. For quality control of DXA scan, one should not fail checking the phantom and Qc in clinical practice
- 7. Bisphosphonates induced atypical femoral fractures can occur even after stopping bisphosphonates
- 8. Situations where BMD is normal other densitometric adjuncts such as hip structure analysis, bone strength index can be used
